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Education-Project 'Muskaan' Strengthening Rural Government Primary Education System



Empowering Teachers through Training

- a) A two-day training programme was organized for Government Primary teachers at Gajraula in association with EZ Vidya, in the month of December and January. The training focused on empowering the teachers with better teaching methods and developing their self-worth. They were taught about innovative and participatory ways of teaching methods so as to hold the attention of students for a longer duration.
- b) A refresher course of the IDEK (Mathematics tool) kit was held for 75 teachers in January. This kit contains Teaching Learning Material (TLM) for mathematics, so as to make the teaching and learning experience of mathematics enjoyable for the students as well as teachers.





Kisse Kahaniyo Ki Ghanti

KisseKahaniyokiGhanti is a community trust building activity under Project Muskaan. Under this activity Senior citizens of villages tell stories to school students which shape up the prestige of the community as wellacquaint the students about the mythology, history and politics of our country. The activity was conducted by JBF Gajraula and Nanjangud at their respective locations. The senior citizens, most of whom were grandparents of the students themselves, were felicitated with blankets and certificates as a token of appreciation.

Teaching Learning Material (TLM) Distribution in Schools

18 schools under Project Muskaan in Gajraula were provided with blackboards, cupboards, pin boards and student files, so as to improve the infrastructure of the schools and also help in the record management system of the schools.

Technical Literacy Training Program

JBF Nanjangud conducted a training programme on tailoring for class 8th students of Debur School under Technical Literacy Programme of Project Muskaan. It was 5 days module in which 32 Students Participated.





Craft Day-Best Out of Waste

The activity was organized in 4 Muskaan Schools of Nanjangud location namely Byalaru, Sujathapuram, Debur and Byalaru.

Around 276 students participated to showcase their extraordinary creativity and imagination. The students were zealous and presented various craft forms which were designed out of waste material.

Educational Tour

The activity was organized by JBF Bharuch and Najangudunder Project Muskaan Students. A group of 250 students (Bhahruch) and 204 Students (Nanjngud) were taken on a exposure visit to places like Science city, Botanical garden, Zoo etc. It is believed that such educational tour enhances the confidence and general awareness and they learn by believing.


Social Entrepreneurship Project

15 Swasthya Praharis have been provided with health and hygiene products that they can sell from their homes like sanitary napkins, baby products, protein supplements, first aid etc. along with these items they have also been provided with display cases to display their products at home. They have also been trained on book-keeping so that they can learn the nuances of business.



Health Cards at Nanjangud-

Primary Health centre are catering to the population of more than 15000 in distantly located villages in Nanjangud namely Kallahalli/Kanakanagar/kathwadipura/Debur/ Handuvinahalli/Byalaru/Gikalli/ Geekahallihundi. Mobile Dispensary team visits 6 days a week covering above said villages. They render medical consultancy and dispensing medicaments including injections, dressing items and immunization provided at a very nominal service charge of Rs.10/- per card. Cases of chronic disorder diagnosed are referred, Govt. hospital for further care & treatment. JBF team provided individual health ID card and health cards to the community members.

Soap Oil and Phenyl Making Training at Kallahalli Village:

JBF Nanjangud organized the Soap oil training in association with RUDSET Mysore for the community in Kallahalli village. Around 36 women participated the training on how to make soap oil, Phenyl, Hand washing oil and glass cleaning oil at a low cost.
