INITIATIVES AROUND JUBILANT FACILITIES ACROSS INDIA



Sanitizer distribution at Gajraula

GAJRAULA

- Equipped Community Health Centre (CHC), Gajraula with Medical Oxygen Supply System
- **2500** Litres of sanitizer & **2000** masks were distributed to Community, District Administration, Amroha and CHC at the onset of the second wave of COVID-19
- **1000** medicine kits were given away to CHC, Gajraula
- **400** pair of gloves were provided to CHC, Gajraula for front line health workers
- **40** pulse oximeters were also provided to CHC, Gajraula

NIRA

- **9000** Litres of sanitizer distributed to Local Gram Panchayat, Police Station, Government Officers, Public Health Centres, Maharashtra Pollution Control Board and Maharashtra State Electricity Board Isolation Centres created by JBF at Nira and Padegaon village
- JBF and Nira Gram Panchayat jointly established COVID-19 isolation center at Jubilant English Medium School in Nira with the provision of beds, steamers, BP monitors, glucometer and pulse oximeters

SAVLI

- **50** PPE kits, **100** Litres sanitizer, **1000** N95 masks, **2000** pair of hand gloves and **200** face shields were given away to Nagar Palika, Savli and Community Health Centre of Savli Taluka
- **3000** masks were distributed in the local community of Savli
- JBF is also providing support to establish a COVID Care Centre with oxygen facility at Savli Taluka for the residents of Savli and nearby villages

- Awareness campaign on the importance of COVID-19 Vaccination organized at Paswa, Karchiya and Juna Samlaya villages of Savli
- **1000** cloth masks were given away to employees, contract workers and labourers

Bharuch

- Several pro-active workshops have been organized for the community with the support of Sarpanch and local administration in villages of Bharuch
- **35** Litres of sanitizers, **2000** masks were distributed at **2** COVID Care Centers at Vagra village of Bharuch

- **175** dry fruit kits were distributed for COVID patients for immunity at COVID Care Centers at Vagra
- **2** oxygen cylinders support was provided to Vorasamni village
- In-house registration of over **300** contractual labourers for vaccination
- **2** oxygen cylinders support was provided to Baccho Ka Ghar and COVID Care Center at Vagra
- Oxygen Concentrator provided at COVID Care Centre at Vagra
- **20** patient beds for Isolation ward in **10** villages of Bharuch
- Medical equipment's support (PPE Kit, Oximeter, Thermal Gun etc) at Community Health Centre, Vagra

Nanjangud

- JBF in association with Nanjangud Taluk Health Department organized a COVID vaccination camp at Kallahalli for villagers who are above **45** years of age
- **100** vials of Jubi-R-Remdesivir were distributed to Mysore District Health Department

- **10** oxygen concentrators given to District Magistrate Office, Mysore
- **1500** medicine kits were provided to Tahsildar Office, Nanjangud, for **19** Primary Health Centers of Nanjangud Taluk

COVID essential distribution at Bharuch

- Jubilant Bhartia Foundation coordinated with **10** employees who voluntarily came forward to donate their plasma and saved lives of Jubilant employees and their family members. However, Jubilant's project that started in the month of March, was closed in May due to new COVID-19 guidelines issued by ICMR
- 266** vials of Jubi-R-Remedesvir has been provided to Chief Medical Officer (CMO) of Gautam Buddha Nagar for treatment of under-served patients
